MINUTES

The Putnam County Dilapidated and Abandoned Enforcement Agency met on Wednesday, March 21, 2007 at the Putnam County Courthouse, Courtroom room 202.

The meeting was called to order at 10:05 a.m. by Chairman Trena Smith.

Roll call was taken and a quorum was present.

ELECTION OF 2007 OFFICERS

A slate of officers was presented by the nominating committee. The slate consisted of Carey Eden, president, Trena Smith, vice president, and Nyle Whittington, secretary. Nominations were closed. OLD BUSINESS - Review of Caselog/Open Cases

Case 2007-01 - NOC letter was received by property owner on March 9, 2007

Case 2006-07 - inspected March 13, 2007; structure demolished; debris remains

Case 2006-08 - staff received report that property cleared; need to reinspect for verification

Case 2006-11 - NOC letter returned as undeliverable

Case 2006-12 - inspected week of March 13, 2007; partially burned structure removed; debris remaining with possible DEP violations

Case 2005-05 - six-month extension ends in May

Case 2005-09 - structure being refurbished

Case 2005-10 - structure not completely removed although trash, etc. has been removed; case will remain open at this time

Case 2005-11 - re-inspected March 13, 2007; structure had been secured although it appears vandals have undone the work

Case 2004-05 - property being used as a dump by unknown persons; staff to send property owner a letter stating the property will be discussed at the May 16, 2007 meeting

Case 2004-10 - trash remains on the property; the abandoned mobile home was secured with cheap-type boards that have sprung loose where warped by the weather; used tires on the property; possible DEP violation

Case 2003-09 - DEP is working closely with Mr. Kelley on this situation

Case 2000-18 - no further action at this time

NEW BUSINESS

There was no new business to discuss.
